# The Power of YES!

### Legislature Statute #343.71: Driver school records, curriculum, and operations.

(5) The department may not license a driver school unless its approved course of instruction does all the following:

**b)** Provides at least 30 minutes of instruction relating to organ and tissue donation and organ and tissue donation procedures.

1. Provide information to assist new drivers in making an informed decision about registering as a donor and saying YES on their driver's license

The student will be able to (TSWBAT):

- a. describe the need for organ and tissue donation.
- b. state who is eligible to donate.
- c. state what organ and/or tissue a person can donate.
- d. explain how the donation process works.
- e. express the importance of making a decision AND the importance of discussing. this decision with your family.
- f. find more resources, if needed.
- g. make an informed decision regarding registering as a donor.
