

INNOVATION AND IMPACT GRANTS 2026 Program Call For Project Proposals

Donate Life Wisconsin (DLW) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to educating, inspiring, and activating Wisconsinites to register as organ, tissue and eye donors. One way DLW supports its mission is through the Innovation and Impact Grants Program.

The 2026 DLW Innovation and Impact Grants cycle will begin accepting *Letters of Intent* (LOI) for 2026 funding applications on April 28, 2025. Projects must be focused on either:

- Increasing number of new individuals who register to become organ, eye and tissue donors.
- Increasing number of donated organs/tissues available for transplantation.

Project proposals must address one or more of the following:

- Unmet need which increase new donor registration or the number of donated organs/tissues in Wisconsin.
- Specific demographic, age or professional group.
- Unique geographic location (county, region or tribal area) in Wisconsin.
- Transformational change in professional/clinical practices, policy or systems.

Proposed projects must begin in January 2026 and be completed by December 31, 2026 – no exceptions. Project budget for funding requests must be between \$10,000-50,000.

Any eligible (non-profit) organization may submit one or more LOIs for funding consideration. Collaborative projects between organizations are encouraged. Organizations located outside of Wisconsin may submit an LOI if the proposed project is conducted in Wisconsin during the grant period.
