Legislature Statute #343.71: Driver school records, curriculum, and operations.

- (5) The department may not license a driver school unless its approved course of instruction does all the following:
 - b) Provides at least 30 minutes of instruction relating to organ and tissue donation and organ and tissue procedures.

This 30-minute PowerPoint presentation provides important facts to future drivers before they consider their decision about registering as an organ, tissue, and eye donor on their driver's license application.
